GATE OPENS at 7:00 AM – GATE CLOSES at 10:00 PM

To help ensure an enjoyable visit, please be aware of the following:

1. Register and pay for your site within 30 minutes after arrival. If you plan to stay additional nights, pay by 11:00 AM each day following. Check out time is 2:00PM.
2. Campsites may not be reserved. Site **MUST** be occupied the first night and not left vacant for more than 24 hours thereafter. Camping equipment must occupy site at time of payment.
3. The Federal Interagency Senior /Access Pass may be used only by the person they are issued. Pass holder may pay for only one site and must occupy that site.
4. Motorbike, motorcycles or other motor vehicles are to be used only for transportation on entering or leaving campground.
5. Trailer and vehicles must have all wheels on the spur. Trailers may be parked on some tent pads. Two vehicles per site, space permitting. Parking is not permitted on unoccupied sites, along roads, nor on the grass.
6. Bicycles may not be ridden after dark.
7. Each campsite is limited to only one family, or group of 8 persons, and must include at least one person 18 years of age or older.
8. No more than 2 tents (or 1 RV and 1 tent) may be on ground at any one site.
9. Pets must be on a leash or in a cage. Please do not bring pets into restrooms. Please clean up after your pet.
10. Campfires are permitted in grills as provided. Dead wood from ground may be used for firewood. Do not cut vegetation or standing trees.
11. Prepare food, wash dishes and clean fish at campsites only, not in restrooms or at hydrants.
12. Please maintain quiet hours from **10:00PM to 7:00AM**. Generators may run a maximum of four hours and only between the hours of **8:00AM and 8:00PM** and only for the purpose of charging batteries.
13. Do not leave hoses hooked up to the water hydrants. Do not run electric cords to restrooms unless authorized by management.
14. Discharge of firearms, including air rifles, and fireworks are prohibited within the campground.
15. You may change campsite only **once** during your stay.
16. **Refunds** may be made only in emergency situations. No refunds are given for weather.
17. Any disorderly conduct or violation of campground rules may result in eviction from the campground by the host.
